ELIMINATE THE CAUSE OF INFECTION (PERIODONTAL DISEASE AND BREATH ODOUR): MANAGING THE SYMPTOMS IS NOT ENOUGH!

The reality of paradigm paralysis: the inability to see beyond the current models of thinking.

Biofilms that induce diseases like periodontitis resist clearance by host defenses and when left undisturbed for some time become increasingly pathogenic. To improve the results in periodontal disease treatment or the treatment of halitosis, oral microbiological diagnostics are combined with adjunctive antibiotic rinses in addition to mechanical debridement. By using a topical antibiotic application through a rinse and spit method, we can amplify the effect compared to systemic antibiotics used to treat periodontal disease and avoid almost all side effects and pharmacological interactions that may occur. This method of topical application is rapid and effective. The change in biofilm alters the inflammatory response from the polymorphonuclear leukocytes (PMN's) and there is a significant amount of healing of gingivitis and periodontitis with 4-7 mm pockets. Once the biofilm is within normal limits, a personalized maintenance system and a good oral hygiene program will keep oral biofilm under control.
